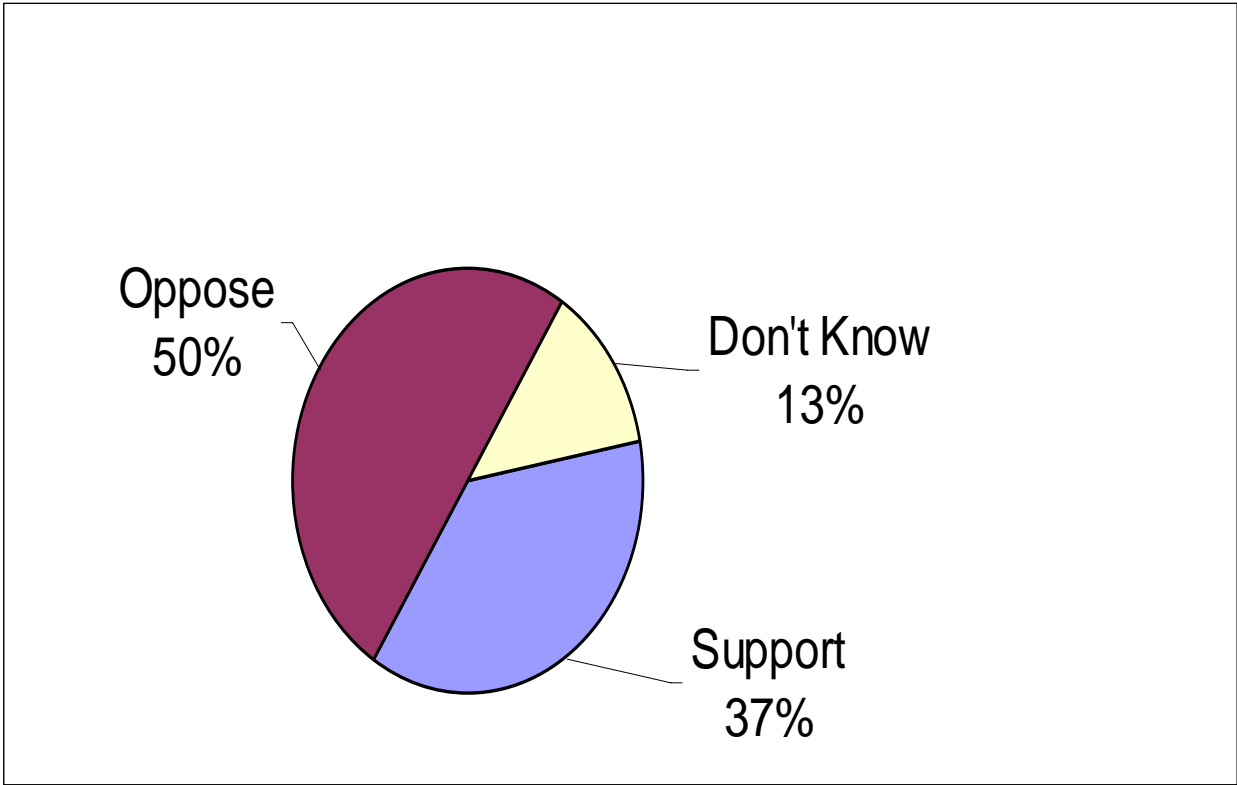
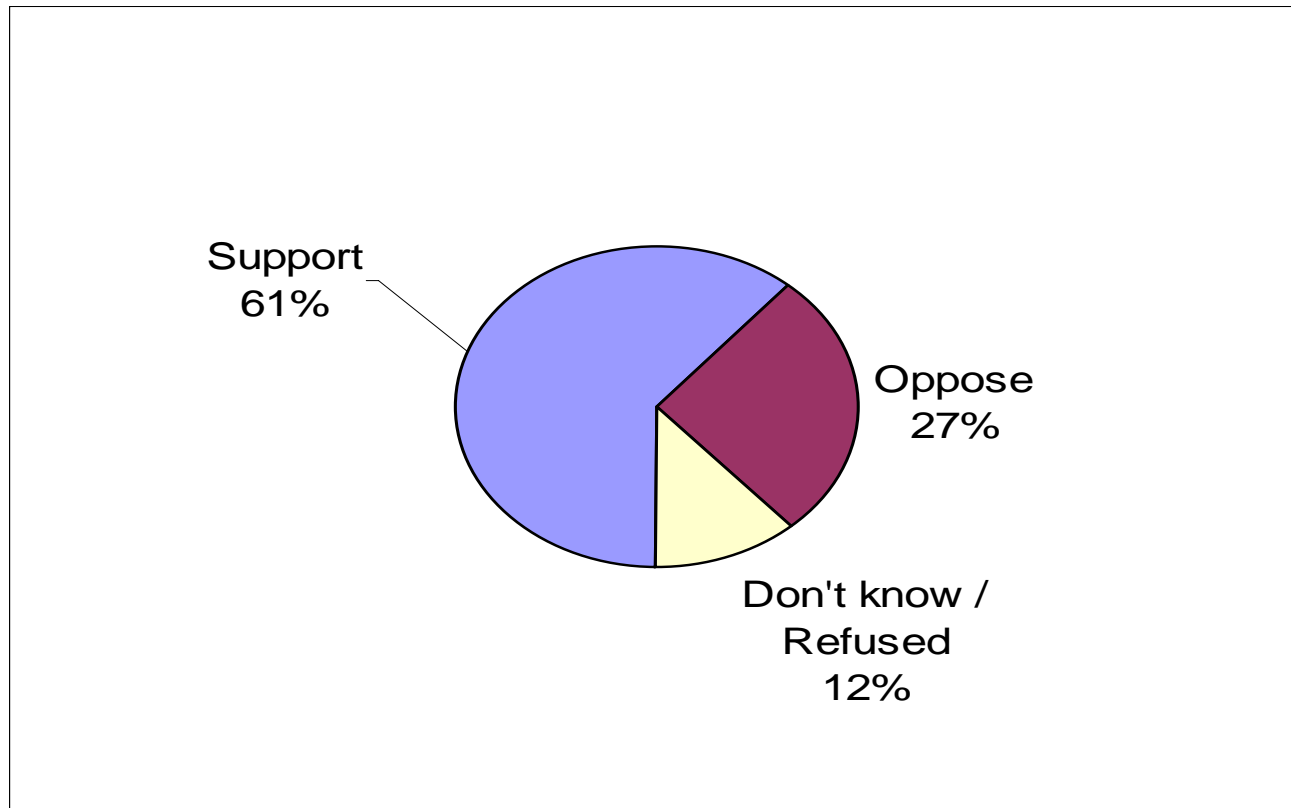


Albertans' Views of Harper government's plan to cancel Childcare agreements and replace with direct payment



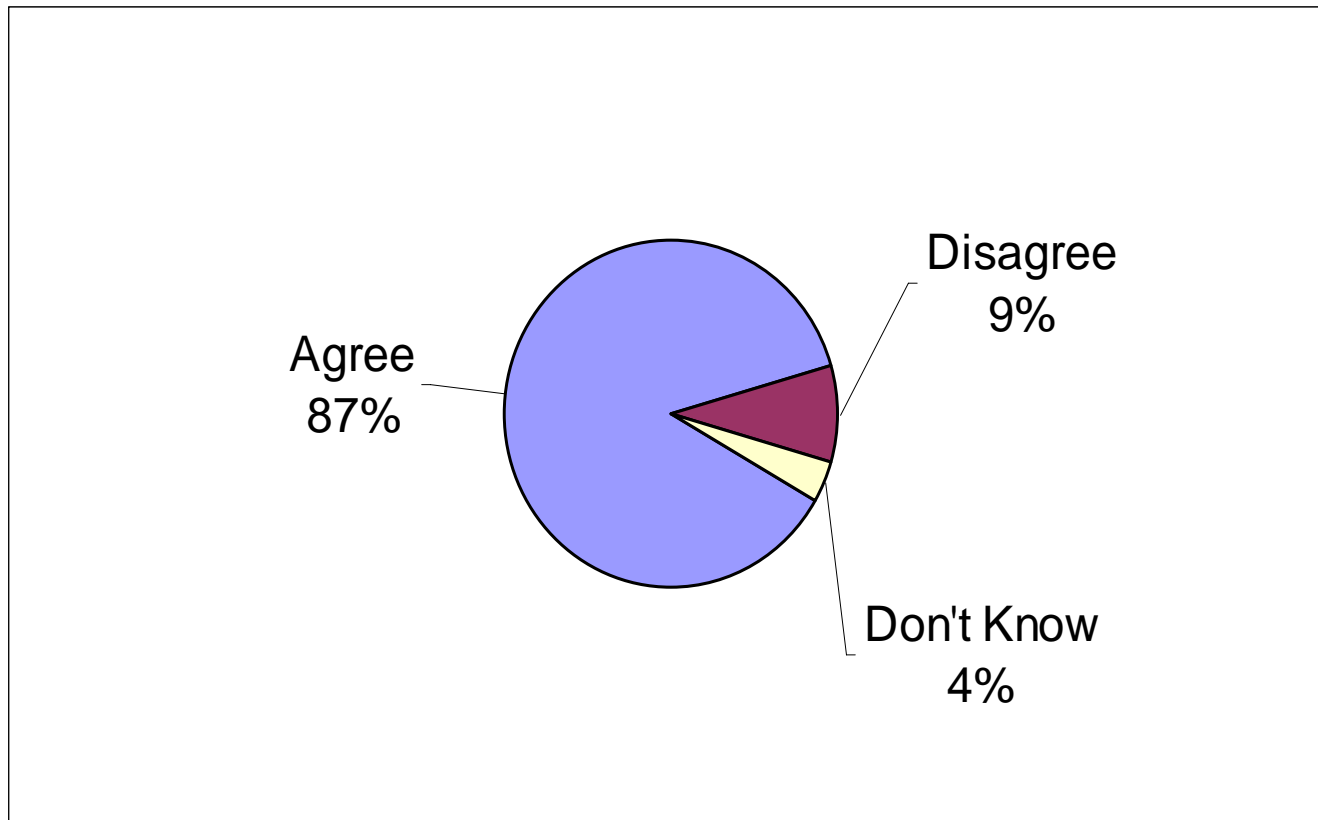

Alberta Government should pay the full cost if the federal government cancels childcare agreement



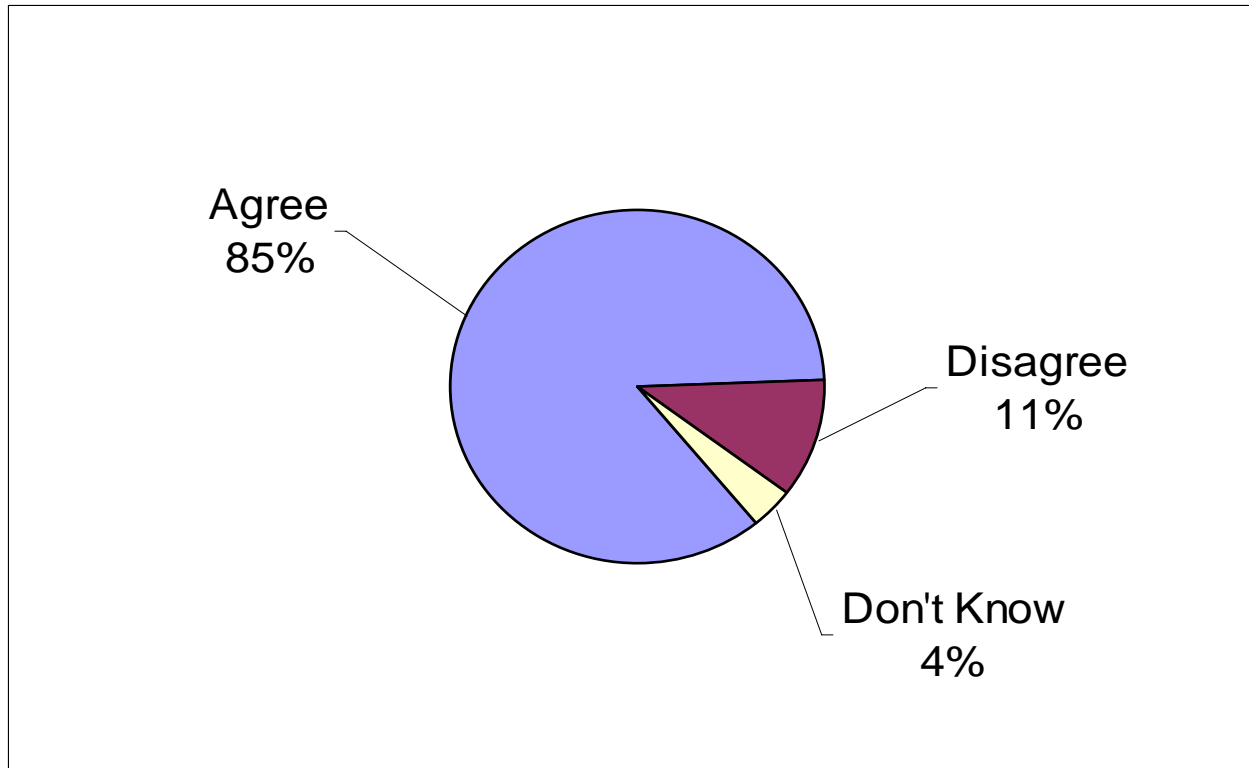
